INVESTIGATORS SEEK ASSISTANCE IN SOLVING TRUMBULL COUNTY ARSON

You May Have Information Valuable to Law Enforcement

The Division of State Fire Marshal is seeking the public's assistance in solving an arson case in Trumbull County that resulted in one fatality. The incident occurred at 461 Parkman Road in Warren, Ohio.

A Blue Ribbon Arson Reward sign has been posted at the address. A reward of up to \$5,000 is being offered by the Blue Ribbon Arson Committee for information leading to the identification of the person or persons responsible for the fires.

"It is imperative that individuals come forward," said State Fire Marshal Larry Flowers. "Investigators want to hear from anyone who saw something out of the ordinary at or around the time of the fire. Any piece of information could be useful to investigators."
