INVESTIGATORS SEEK ASSISTANCE IN SOLVING ARSON IN SCIOTO COUNTY

You May Have Information Valuable to Law Enforcement

The Division of State Fire Marshal is seeking information from the public regarding a fire that was intentionally set. Investigators have evidence that points to arson at 1809 Jackson Street in Portsmouth on Sunday, June 8, 2014.

The fire occurred at approximately 1:31 a.m. Investigators said a Chevy Venture Van was set on fire in front of a home. A family of six was inside the home at the time, but got out safely thanks to a passerby who alerted the occupants inside. Portsmouth Fire Department responded to the scene. The investigation is being conducted in conjunction with the Portsmouth Police Department and the Portsmouth Fire Department.

A reward of up to \$5,000 is being offered by the Blue Ribbon Arson Committee for information leading to the identification of the person or persons responsible for the fire. Investigators believe there could be video of the incident, and ask any individuals in possession of those recordings to contact them.

"Information from the public is crucial to solving these kinds of cases," said State Fire Marshal Larry Flowers. "Investigators want to hear from anyone who saw something out of the ordinary at or around the time of the fire or who may have heard someone speaking about the fire with an unusual level of interest or knowledge."
