**INVESTIGATORS SEEKING TIPS FROM THE
PUBLIC REGARDING HOLLAND ARSON**

You May Have Information Valuable to Law Enforcement

The Division of State Fire Marshal's Fire & Explosion Investigation Bureau is seeking information relating to a fire that was intentionally set to a home at 240 South Meilke Road in Holland.

The fire occurred around 2:00 a.m. on Friday, March 3. The Springfield Township Fire Department responded to the fire. The investigation is being conducted in conjunction with the fire department and the Lucas County Sheriff's Office.

A reward of up to \$5,000 is being offered by the [Blue Ribbon Arson Committee](#) for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the fire.

"If you have any small piece of information, anything, it could be exactly what our investigators need to close this," State Fire Marshal Larry L. Flowers said.
